





Tips in the Current Market

- The three most important factors
- Price vs. Risk
 - Get to Know the Sellers
 - Major Auction Houses
 - Established Dealers
 - eBay, Delcampe, HipStamp, etc.
- Online Buying
 - Image Quality
 - Fronts & Backs
 - Print Clarity
 - Look for Details
- Expertizing
 - Requires in-depth expertise
 - SG cites BPA as "gold standard"
